

# Legacies & Wills

**St. Thomas', Brampton Parochial Church Council**  
**(Charity Number 1138026)**

*Below are some suggested Will clauses you or your solicitor can use to give a share of your estate:*

I give \_\_\_\_\_% of my residuary estate free of all taxes to the Parochial Church Council of the parish of **St Thomas Brampton with St Peter's Holymoorside** (Charity Number 1138026) in the Diocese of Derby for its general purposes, and I declare that the receipt of an officer of the Parochial Church Council shall be a sufficient discharge to my executors.

If you prefer to give a fixed sum of money replace the words in red above with:

*'I give the sum of £\_\_\_\_\_ (\_\_\_\_\_).'* Write the amount in numbers and then in words in the brackets, for clarity.

If you would like to give to a number of different parts of the Church and other charities, you can use 'The Legacy Service from the Church of England' (see [www.churchlegacy.org.uk](http://www.churchlegacy.org.uk) for more information). This service lets you support several different parts of the Church and other charities with just one gift in your Will; and you can change your wishes freely at any time.

If you already have a Will, you can use the codicil form to add a gift to the church.
